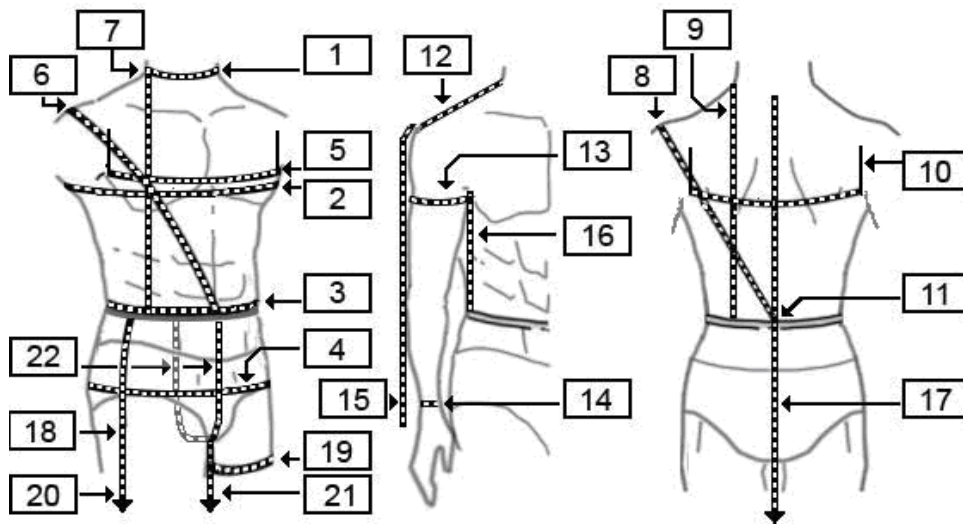

### Explanations:

N	Name	Explanation.
1	Neck girth.	
2	Chest girth.	Taking high points of shoulder-blades and chest.
3	Waist girth	
4	Hips girth.	Taking high points of buttocks and abdomen.
5	Chest width.	The distance between armpits. It is taken with arms down.
6	The oblique height of the shoulder (front).	These 2 measurements (6 and 8) are to be taken with the single touch of tape-measure from the crossing point of waist-band and backbone to the highest point of the shoulder (8), then through the chest center to the adjusting waist-band in the front (6).
8	The oblique height of the shoulder (back).	
7	From the waist to the shoulder in front.	These 2 measurements (7 and 9) are to be taken with the single touch of tape-measure from the adjusting waist-band to the neck basis (9), then through the highest point of the chest to the adjusting waist-band in the front (7).
9	From the waist to the shoulder at the back.	
10	Back width.	The distance between armpits through the shoulder blades. It is taken with arms down.
11	From the 7-th neck vertebra down to the waist.	
12.	Shoulder width.	Taking from the neck basis to the shoulder cut (the desirable shoulder width of a tailsuit).
13.	Shoulder girth.	Taking at the armpit level.
14.	Wrist girth.	
15	The length of the sleeve.	Taking from the highest point of the shoulder to the wrist.
16	From the waist to the arm-pit.	Put the plain thing (for example, ruler or hair brush) under the armpit and measure from its edge to the adjusting waist-band.
17	The length of the product (as you wish)	Taking from the adjusting waist-band in the back to the desirable length of a product.
18	The side length of trousers. From the waist to the floor	Taking from the adjusting waist-band in the back to the desirable length of the trousers.
19.	Hip (leg) girth.	
20	The lowest width of the trousers-leg.	The desirable trousers width at the bottom.
21.	The inside length of the trousers.	The length of the inside seam.
22	The seat depth.	Taking from the adjusting waist-and in the back then between the legs to the adjusting waist-band in the front.
